

Bugs DO NOT Fixed With This Release

TABLE 0-1 lists the bugs that have NOT been (or will NOT be) fixed in this version of the software.

TABLE 0-1 Bugs Integrated with Web Rank 2.0 Release

Bug ID Number	Description of Bug
Bug Id 842	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Intl/findwhat: Some search results missing URL information causing extractor to save empty string into simulation database.
Bug Id 855	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Australia/wombat: Web Rank 2.0 does not extract the "EXPRESS" (sponsored) area data.
Bug Id 857	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Belgium/search-belgium: Some search results do not have URL information (DOM path data is empty). Causes Web Rank to report wrong position information. Belgium/tiscali is merged with MSN
Bug Id 860	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> China/soho: The result index is non-continuous. For example, page 1 contains the 1st to 19th search result, and page 2 may contain the 21st to 39th search result while the 20th result is missing.
Bug Id 876	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Spain/spotting: The www.espotting.com URL has been changed to www.miva.com/es/index.asp and it is now a pay search engine.
Bug Id 915	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Do NOT filter empty/tab keywords or URLs. Search engines allow user to search with empty/tab string.
Bug Id 920	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Intl/kanoodle: For some search results, both the title and URL are extracted and recorded to "Rank" category. It will cause Web Rank to display the wrong position number.
Bug Id 921	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Intl/webcrawl: Do NOT classify the search result into rank or sponsored category. The reason is Intl/webcrawl has indexed the result. It is not suitable to separate rank/sponsored data although extractor can classify it.
Bug Id 923	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Argentina/aol: Mixed-up rank/sponsored area data. The reason is web site uses image as area tag instead of the recognizable string. It is a current limitation of the extractor.
Bug Id 928	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> For Web Rank 2.0, the default maximum page number has been changed from 5 to 2. The smaller value makes response times quicker.
